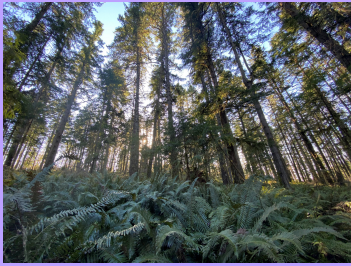


# Fern Woods

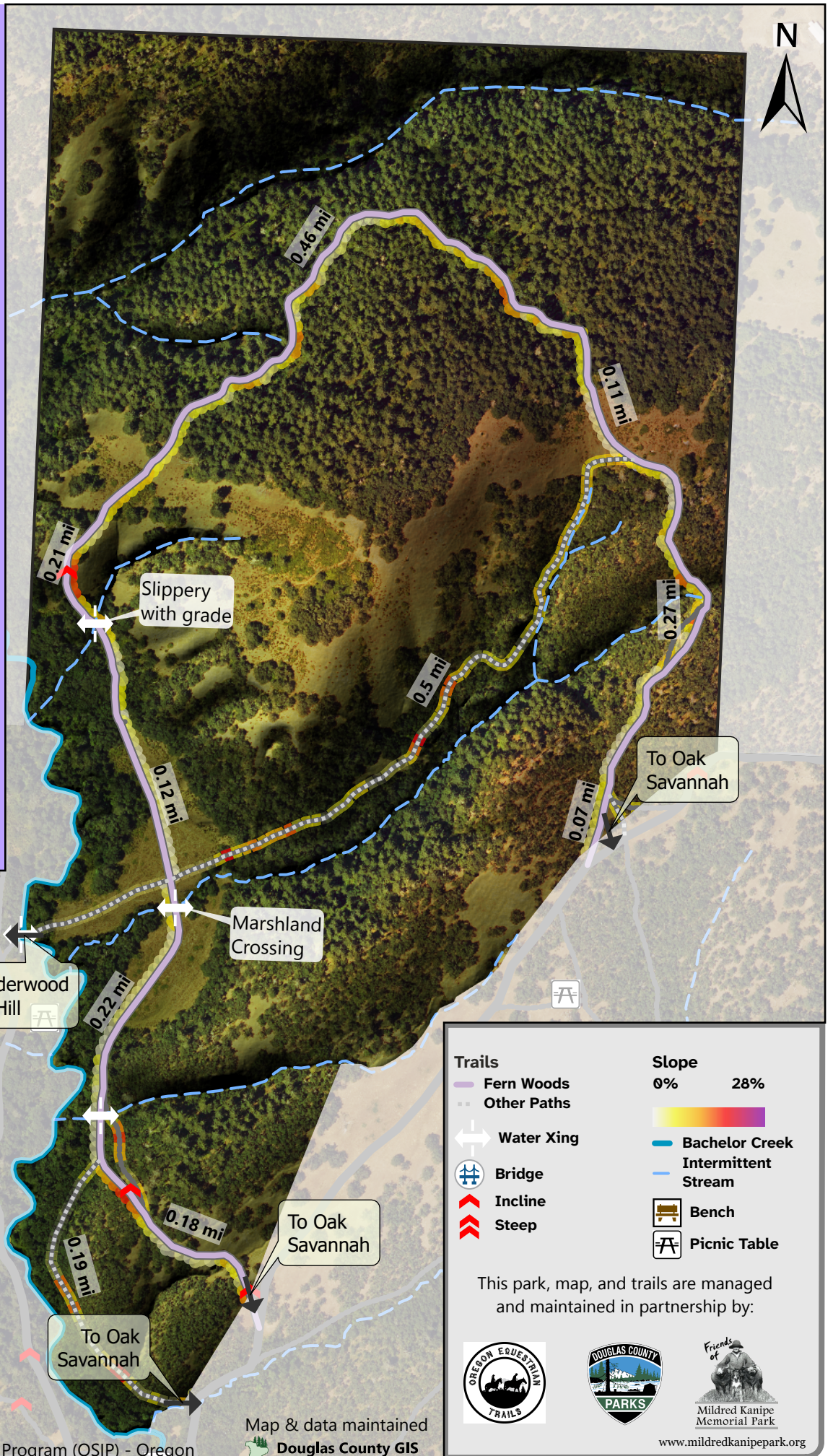
(Loop 1.64 Miles)
